



# Liébana, El Misterio 2019



**Type of wine:** Red wine

**Strength:** 14% ABV

**Grape varieties:** 100% Mencía

**Appellation:** Liébana

**Age of vines:** Grapes sourced from hundred-year-old vines from high altitude plots

**Harvesting:** Grapes harvested by hand

**Vinification Process:** Grapes crushed and fermented in wooden vats with partial inclusion of stems. Aged for 12 months in the best oak barrels.

**Fermentation:** Alcoholic fermentation in wooden vats

**Tasting notes:** Garnet cherry color with violet hues

Enveloping, elegant and slightly oily texture

Aromas and flavors of plum jam, ripe tannins provide a silky and fresh finish

**Comments:** "El Misterio" is the first release in a special, limited and numbered collection from Picos de Cabariezo winery in Cantabria, Spain. The label design will change each year, always featuring a motif dedicated to the region.

**Presentation:** Numbered, limited edition 750ml bottle

**Serving temperature:** 15-17°C

**Food Pairings:** The bold flavors and structure of this Mencía-based red would pair well with grilled or roasted red meats, hearty stews, and aged cheeses.
