



TASTING NOTE:

Wonderful range of floral notes and exotic fruits.
Long and elegant on the palate. Excellent balance between acidity and unctuousness that envelopes the palate with a slightly sweet touch and a smooth, delicate finish.

SERVING:

Serving temperature: between 6°C and 8°C

TERRAIN:

Area: D.O. Alicante

District: Alto Vinalopó

Grape varieties: 40% Muscat, 40% Sauvignon Blanc and 20% Macabeo

Harvest: second fortnight in August

Altitude: 500-600 metres above sea level

Climate: the average annual temperature ranges from 6°C to 24°C; over 3,000 hours of sunshine per year

Soil: mostly limestone, loams and clays

Terrain: valleys with SW/NE Prebaetic System corridors transitioning between the Manchegan and Levantine landscapes

Precipitation: 250 mm on average per year

Vine age: 7 years

ANALYSIS:

Fermentation at 15°C in stainless steel tanks

Alcohol content: 11%

Total acidity: 6.1 g/l as tartaric acid

Volatile acidity: 0.35 g/l as acetic acid
