Type of wine: Red wine aged in oak barrels (roble in Spanish)

Strength: 14% ABV

Grape varieties: Mencía and Syrah

Appellation: Liébana

Vinification Process: After fermentation, the wine was aged for 6 months in oak barrels

Fermentation: Alcoholic fermentation

Tasting notes: Aromas and flavors of ripe red fruits, spice, and oak notes. Smooth, well-integrated tannins.

Comments: Picos de Cabariezo is a winery located in Cantabria, Spain. Their "Finca Morillas" Mencia and Syrah blend is aged for 6 months in oak barrels before bottling.

Presentation: 750ml bottle

Serving temperature: 15-18°C

Food Pairings: The bold flavors and structure of this Mencía and Syrah blend make it a great pairing for grilled meats, roasted vegetables, and hearty stews.
